

OAK CREEK LIONSFEST FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1) Is there an admission fee or parking fee? No, it is free to enter LionsFest and to park!
- 2) How do I get to LionsFest? We are 2 miles east of I-94, and three blocks north of Ryan Rd. at 9327 S. Shepard Ave.
- 3) What happens if it rains? LionsFest will remain open! We will run the festival rain or shine.
- 4) How much does the Helicopter ride cost and what else do I need to know? It varies every year, and 2-3 people can ride in the helicopter. This should be discussed with the pilot. It will run weather permitting.
- 5) Can I bring my dog or other pets?

Service animals are allowed. The ADA requires that service animals be under the control of the handler at all times. The service animal must be harnessed, leashed, or tethered while in public places unless these devices interfere with the service animal's work or the person's disability prevents use of these devices.
